



### **Expectations of Students and Parents**

1. **Attendance.** Students must be present for all parts of the school day, arrive on time, and dress according to the school's dress code. They must participate in the after-school and evening study programs (if academically required), as well as the Summer Program.
2. **Behavior.** Students must be respectful at all times to themselves, to others, and to all objects around them. Whining, bullying, and talking back to teachers is unacceptable at all times. Fighting or vandalism incurs suspension.
3. **Assignments.** Students must be responsible. This includes maintaining their assignment book and doing daily homework assignments, which may take up to two hours to complete. Students are responsible for getting homework and/or assignments when they are sick or absent.
4. **Meals.** Students must be provided with a snack and lunch everyday. No student may use a microwave to cook any food at the school. Parents are required to make lunch for the teachers up to three times a year.
5. **Summer Program.** All students must participate in a four-week summer program during the month of July. Students come to school every morning for an hour of Math or Reading/Language Arts. The boys then participate in an off-site day camp in the Hartford area.
6. **Transportation.** Parents or family members must provide daily, on-time transportation for students on regular class days. Car-pooling can be arranged with other students' families. Faculty members are not permitted to drive students to or from school.
7. **Activities Fee.** All parents pay an activities fee of \$100 to help cover the cost of their son's education. We encourage family support during the year (e.g. volunteering to help in various student activities).
8. **Parent Meetings.** Parents must maintain regular attendance at Parent Council Meetings, which are held the first Monday of every month. Parents are also required to meet with teachers four times a year for Report Card meetings, and once a year for Progress Report Meetings.
9. **Evening Study.** Students must attend Evening Study on Mondays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays from 6:30-8:30 PM if they are receiving 2 Cs, 1 D, or 1 F in any of their main academic subjects.

*Students and parents who do not meet these expectations may be asked to leave Covenant Prep.*
